At the November 25th Board of Directors meeting, the 2025 budget was approved.

At the November 25th Board of Directors meeting, the 2025 budget was approved. Beginning in January, monthly dues for Lake Padgett Estates East will increase to \$60 per month. This adjustment is necessary to address rising costs, including increases in the cost of living, minimum wage, and, most significantly, insurance premiums.

Our insurance premiums, the community's largest expense, played the most significant role in this increase. Did you know that LPEE's DCRs require the association to carry a \$10 million insurance policy? This stipulation was put in place by the developers back in 1972. For many years, finding coverage that met this requirement was manageable. However, since the Surfside Condominium collapse in 2021, securing the proper insurance has become increasingly difficult and costly.

What was once covered by a single policy now requires two separate policies, with the secondary policy being substantially more expensive. The Board of Directors has been working diligently to secure the necessary funding for these premiums, but these challenges have highlighted the need for change.

In response, the Board plans to propose a modification to the DCRs that would reduce the insurance requirement from \$10 million to \$5 million. This adjustment would bring LPEE's requirements in line with most other communities and significantly alleviate the financial burden.

For this change to take effect, it must be approved by 2/3 of homeowners in good standing. When this proposal is brought to a vote, your participation will be critical! This change could help ensure that dues remain affordable for years to come.

2025 Payment Information

Coupon books for 2025 dues should arrive by mid-December. If you have automatic withdrawal set up, there is no need to make any changes. However, if you use Bill Pay, please ensure you include the following information for proper processing: **2433**, **LPE**, **and your lot number.** You can also continue to pay in person at the office. Please remember we accept cash, check, or money order only.

We hope everyone has a safe and happy holiday season! Thank you for your continued support, and we look forward to seeing you in the new year.
