From the Architectural Administrator

At Lake Padgett Estates East, we take pride in maintaining the natural beauty of our community. Proper tree care is essential not only for aesthetic purposes but also for safety and the health of the trees themselves. As we approach the season for tree trimming, we'd like to remind residents of the importance of this maintenance and provide some guidelines to ensure a consistent and safe approach.

Why Tree Trimming is Important

- 1. **Health of Trees**: Regular trimming helps trees grow stronger and healthier by removing dead or diseased branches. This promotes new growth and increases the lifespan of the trees.
- 2. **Safety**: Overgrown or damaged branches can pose a hazard during storms or high winds. Trimming reduces the risk of falling branches that could cause injury or property damage.
- 3. **Aesthetics**: Well-maintained trees enhance the overall appearance of our community. Proper trimming ensures trees maintain a desirable shape and size, contributing to the beauty of our neighborhood.

Guidelines for Tree Trimming

- 1. **Timing**: The best time to trim trees is during the dormant season, typically in late winter before spring growth begins. However, dead or hazardous branches should be removed promptly, regardless of the season.
- 2. **Techniques**: Use proper techniques to avoid damaging the tree. Make clean cuts just outside the branch collar (the swollen area where the branch joins the trunk). Avoid leaving stubs or cutting too close to the trunk.
- 3. **Height and Spread**: Maintain trees at a height and spread that is appropriate for their species and location. Ensure branches are at least 10 feet away from structures and do not obstruct sidewalks or roadways.
- 4. **Professional Services**: For large trees or extensive trimming, consider hiring a professional tree service. They have the expertise and equipment to safely and effectively trim trees without causing harm.
- 5. **Disposal**: Properly dispose of all trimmings. Do not leave branches or debris on sidewalks, roadways, or common areas. Utilize the designated yard waste disposal services provided by the community.

Adhering to these guidelines ensures that we all contribute to a safe and beautiful environment. Residents are reminded to stay in compliance with community standards regarding tree maintenance. Failure to properly maintain trees may result in violations and potential fines.

The penalty for Illegally passing a stopped school bus while displaying a stop signal is \$200. Illegally passing on the side children enter/exit is \$400.

Your license can be suspended for a 2nd violation within a 5-year period.

Your phone must be hands-free in a school zone.

Multi-lane paved across Vehicles traveling in both directions MUST stop.

Divided Roadway On a highway divided by a median, cars traveling in the opposite direction are not required to stop but should proceed with caution.
