# From the Desk of the Architectural Administrator

### \*\*May is Pressure Washing Month: Time to Spruce Up Your Home and Yard!\*\*

As we welcome the warmer days of spring, it's the perfect time to give our homes and surroundings a thorough cleaning. This May, let's focus on making our neighborhood the pride of the community by tackling some common upkeep tasks.

- 1. Say Goodbye to Mold and Grime:\*\* Notice mold creeping up on the side of your house? See dirt buildup on your driveway? This month, consider pressure washing these areas to refresh the look of your home.
- 2. Lawn and Garden Care:\*\* Our community prides itself on tidy and vibrant landscapes. If your shrubs are overgrown, now is the time to trim them back to a manageable height—no taller than three feet. Similarly, let's ensure our flower beds are free of weeds and debris. A little effort goes a long way in enhancing our neighborhood's curb appeal.
- 3. *Tree Maintenance*:\*\* Dead branches not only look unsightly but can also pose a hazard during storms. Take a moment to inspect the trees and palms around your home, removing any dead limbs and spent palm fronds.
- 4. *Parking Regulations*:\*\* A gentle reminder that parking on the grass is not permitted within our community. Please use designated driveways or parking areas instead. This helps preserve the beauty and integrity of our landscaped areas.
- 5. *Keep Trash Cans Out of Sight*:\*\* Trash bins should be stored in a way that they are not visible from the front of the house. By keeping these bins out of sight, we maintain the aesthetic of our streetscape.


